	<b>3SHAY</b>	3 Truck Shay	A hand rung bell and distinctive whistle are the hallmarks of our 4 <sup>th</sup> Shay - the heaviest yet!	Perfect for the Bachmann 55 Ton 3 Truck Shay.
	<b>1361</b>	Pennsy K4 #1361	Mechanical bell. Whistle unique to #1361	Pennsy K4 4-6-2 Pacific #1361. Good choice for Aristocraft 4-6-2 Pacific or Accucraft K4.
	<b>440</b>	American 4-4-0	Classic turn of the century American steam.	Perfect for the Bachmann or Hartland 4-4-0
	<b>ACS1</b>	American Classic Steam	Medium chuff; airy whistle.	Any standard or narrow gauge, small to medium size steam locomotive.
	<b>ACS2</b>	American Classic Steam	Heavy chuff, Solid whistle.	Any medium to heavy steam locomotive.
	<b>BIGBOY</b>	Union Pacific 4-8-8-4 Big Boy	Dual Chuff. New Compressor.	USA Trains, Accucraft or any other Big Boy
	<b>C16</b>	Consolidation	Colorado narrow gauge C16 prototypical sound.	Use in Aristocraft or Accucraft C16, C19 or similar locomotives.
	<b>C21</b>	Consolidation	C21 Consolidation prototypical sound.	Use in Accucraft C21 or similar locomotives.
	<b>CABF</b>	Southern Pacific 4-8-8-2 Cab Forward	Oil burning engine, horn and dual cross compound non-stack venting air compressors make a truly unique sound.	Designed for the Accucraft Cab Forward Locomotive.
	<b>CLMX</b>	Climax	Climax prototypical chuff and whistle	Any Climax or other geared engine.
	<b>DAY</b>	Daylight	SP #4449. Heavy chuff. Daylight style moaning whistle and air horn	Good for Aristocraft 4-6-2 Pacific, Lionel 4-6-4 Hudson, LGB 2-8-2 Mikado, Accucraft GS-4 etc.
	<b>DOCK</b>	0-6-0 Dockside Switcher	Typical chuff and whistle for a light switcher.	New injector sound!
	<b>DRGW</b>	Denver & Rio Grande Western	Road typical chuff and whistle for D&RGW narrow gauge	Recorded from Cumbres and Toltec. Ideal for LGB Mogul, Bachmann 10-wheeler etc.
	<b>EBT</b>	East Broad Top	Road typical chuff for narrow gauge 2-8-2 Mikado. Very melodic whistle.	Recorded at East Broad Top. Similar to WP&YR #73 and Cumbres & Toltec Mikados.
	<b>FRIS</b>	Frisco #1522	Specific sound for Frisco #1522	Recorded from museum and excursion use of the famous Frisco #1522.
	<b>GTW</b>	GTW #6406	Prototypical sound for the Grand Trunk Western and Canadian National lines.	The Weaver U4B is ideal for this sound. This is also suitable for the Polar Express.
	<b>GYPSY</b>	Gypsy	Prototypical sound for a small logging locomotive with an independent steam donkey.	Created for the MoLoCo gypsy
	<b>HEIS</b>	Heisler	Prototypical sound for Heisler steam locomotive.	Accucraft, Bachmann or any Heisler or other geared locomotive
	<b>HDSON</b>	4-6-4 Hudson	Prototypical sound for NYC Hudson steam locomotive.	The 4-6-4 J1e Hudson from USA.
	<b>K480</b>	Baldwin K36 2-8-2 Mikado #480	Prototypical sound for K36 such as on Durango & Silverton	any K36, K37, 2-8-0 Outside Frame Consolidation or other Colorado-style narrow gauge 2-8-2 Mikado
	<b>K463</b>	K27 Mikado #463	Exact prototypical sound for Rio Grande #463.	Accucraft narrow gauge K27 2-8-2 Mikado in any road name.
	<b>K473</b>	K28 Mikado #473	Exact prototypical sound for Rio Grande #473.	LGB Aster or Accucraft narrow gauge K28 2-8-2 Mikado in any road name.
	<b>MALL</b>	2-8-8-2 Mallet	Special articulated engine, horn and air compressor make a truly distinctive sound.	Designed for the Aristocraft 2-8-8-2 Mallet Locomotive.
	<b>MOGUL</b>	2-6-0 Mogul	Classic late 19th / early 20th century American steam sounds	Bachmann's Spectrum collection 2-6-0
	<b>NORTH</b>	Northern Steam Locomotive	Prototypical heavy chuff for 4-8-4 Northern class locomotive. Lonely, distant whistle.	Any standard gauge heavy steam locomotive such as a Mikado or Pacific.
	<b>PORT</b>	Porter	Prototypical chuff and whistle for Porter locomotive	LGB Porter or Aristo 0-4-0 switcher, Rogers 2-4-0, or any other similar small steam locomotive.
	<b>PSHAY</b>	38 Ton Shay	Prototypical sound for the 38 Ton Phoenix Industries Shay.	Designed for the Bachmann 38 ton Shay. See also WEST and SHAY sounds.
	<b>PRR</b>	Pennsylvania Railroad	Road typical chuff and shrill whistle of Pennsy. Hand rung bell.	Perfect for Accucraft K4, Aristo Pacific, LGB Mikado or similar standard gauge steam in PRR livery.
	<b>RGS</b>	Rio Grande Southern	4-6-0 Road typical chuff and unique RGS whistle.	RGS and other Colorado narrow gauge steam locomotives. Bachmann 4-6-0, LGB 2-6-0 and Berlyn T-19.
	<b>SHAY</b>	36 ton Shay	Prototypical sound for logging and mining narrow gauge Shays.	For any Shay. See also WEST and PSHAY.
	<b>SPAC</b>	Southern Pacific	SP #1218 prototypical sound.	Good for Aristocraft Pacific 4-6-2, LGB 2-8-2 or any other standard gauge medium to heavy steam locomotive.
	<b>SRRL</b>	Sandy River & Rangeley Lakes Forney	Prototypical sound for Forney. Unique spitting whistle.	Recorded from Edaville Forney. Perfect for LGB SR&RL Forney or any other Forney
	<b>UINT</b>	Uintah	Double chuff creates proper in and out of phase sound for narrow gauge Mallet.	LGB Uintah #50 or #51 or Sumpter Valley Mallet
	<b>V&amp;T</b>	Virginia & Truckee	Road typical sound for V&T wood burner. No dynamo. Dry chuff, smooth whistle.	Recorded from V&T Inyo #22. Any light to medium steam locomotive.
	<b>WEST</b>	Westside Lumber Shay	Prototypical sound for Westside Shay. Thumpy chuff. Notable 3-cylinder rhythm.	Perfect for any Shay, especially the Accucraft WSL #15 Shay.
